I refer to your letter of the 22nd May, ref. M.S. 51/15/209 and wish to inform you that this Council has no objection to leasing of an area of foreshore at Kinnegoe Bay, provided the Sub-Aqua Club continue to allow the public access to the beach and foreshore area for which they are applying for a lease. The area is used extensively by holiday makers and is beside the White Strand at Glenagivney. It is the Council's opinion that no visitors should be excluded from any part of the fore shore in this area.

The Council would be interested to learn if items recovered from the wreck of the Spanish Armada vessel would be available for display in Donegal and I would be obliged for your advice in this matter. I understand that materials in the nature of guns retrieved from a wreck about two years ago became neglected and ~~was~~ permitted to lie out in the open air, ~~it~~ quickly rusted or deteriorated. It is unlikely that anything similar will happen to items recovered by the City of Derry Sub-Aqua Club.
